- Founded in 1988 at the Technical University in Delft, The Netherlands
- Presently includes 68 national and regional chapters worldwide.
- The International Secretariat office was in Delft until 2000, in Paris through 2009, and in Barcelona from 2010 until a recent relocation to Lisbon.
- The organization is governed by an elected Executive Committee with representation from each national chapter.
- DOCOMOMO International publishes the biannual periodical *DOCOMOMO Journal*—the only international periodical devoted to current events and recent research on the Modern Movement.
- International Specialist Committees (ISCs) composed of recognized experts organize technical seminars and consolidate expertise.
- The International Secretariat organizes an international DOCOMOMO conference held every two years.
- DOCOMOMO International assists UNESCO, the World Heritage Center, ICOMOS, IUA and other organizations in compiling lists of cultural properties to be protected.
